## Mar 10, Mon: Depart for Rome from LAX, CA. Mar 11, Tue: Arrival-Rome

Upon landing at Rome Airport, we will pick up our luggage and proceed to be greeted by our tour guide and/or driver. We will be escorted to the bus and transfer to our Hotel for dinner and overnight.

Mar 12, Wed: Rome-Papal Audience-Catacombs: Following breakfast, we will make our way to St. Peter's Square to attend the Papal Audience, led by His Holiness, Pope Francis. (Papal Audience: Is scheduled to take place every Wednesday, pending the schedule of Pope Francis.) Free time for lunch (not included) Following the Audience we will visit the Catacombs where the early Christians hid themselves to escape persecution. The tour will continue with the visit St Paul. Outside the Walls. Continue our tour via the Appian Way -- the oldest road from Roman times--plus the famous Domino Quo Vadis Chapel; see the ancient Baths of Caracalla, Arch of Drusus; Tomb of Celilia Metella. Dinner & overnight in Rome.

## Mar 13, Thu: Rome-Vatican- Basilica of St. John the Lateran and St. Mary Major-Holy Steps

Breakfast at the hotel. Today, with your guide we will visit the Vatican Museums, containing a group of the most impressive edifices with hundreds of galleries filled with art treasures. See awe-inspiring relics, and works of art donated throughout centuries as tributes of faith. We'll cover The Tapestry Gallery, The Raphael Rooms and the most overwhelming Sistine Chapel, Michelangelo's Masterpiece, restored mural of the Last Judgment. Next we make our way back into St. Peter's Basilica. Pope Francis visited the tomb of St. Peter, following his elevation, for a visit of devotion that lasted 45 minutes. He is the first Pontiff to visit the necropolis since extensive archaeological excavations were conducted at the ancient site decades ago. We will also visit the tomb of St. John Paul II located at the Vatican. Free time for lunch (not included) In the afternoon, we will visit the Basilica of St. John the Lateran, the Pope's cathedral church where relics of both Peter and Paul remain under the main altar. It was here that Pope Francis was formally installed as Bishop of Rome. Next we see the Holy Staircase which is believed to be a staircase from Pilate's palace in Jerusalem and brought to Rome by St. Helen in the 4th century. Time permitting we may climb the steps on our knees in memory of Christ's Passion. Continue to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, the most important and the oldest church dedicated to Our Lady. St. Mary Major contains a relic from the Manger of the infant Jesus. At the end of the tour transfer back to the hotel for dinner & overnight.

#### Mar 14, Fri: Rome-Monte cassino-San Giovanni Rotunda

Breakfast at the hotel and check out. In the morning departure with our private bus with destination San Giovanni Rotondo. Before reaching San Giovanni rotondo we will stop in Montecassino for a visit at the Monastery of the Benedictine Order, founded by Saint Benedict around 530 A.D. then we shall drive (approximately three hours) toward San Giovanni Rotunda, the hometown of Saint Padre Pio. We will stop on the way for lunch (not included) After lunch, once arrived in San Giovanni Rotondo check in and accommodation at the hotel. Rest of the day free.

#### Mar 15, Sat: San Giovanni Rotunda-St. Michael's Cave

Breakfast at the hotel. We start our day early after breakfast with a visit to the Church of Padre Pio; Known as (Pio da Pietrelcina in Italian), he is venerated as a Saint of the Catholic church. He became famous for exhibiting stigmata for most of his life, thereby generating much interest and controversy. He was both beatified (1999) and canonized (2002) by Pope John Paul II. Then we drive to St. Michael's Cave. We visit the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel, a shrine consecrated by St. Michael. At this grotto, St. Michael appeared to a Bishop to assure him that his diocese would not be annihilated as he feared Free time for lunch (not included) At the end of the visit return at the hotel in San Giovanni Rotondo and rest of the day at leisure. Dinner (not included), Overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo.

# Mar 16, Sun: San Giovanni Rotundo-Lanciano-Assisi

Breakfast at the hotel and check out. After breakfast we leave San Giovanni rotondo and drive to the city of Lanciano to visit the "Sanctuary of Eucharistic Miracle" This wondrous Event took place in the 8th century A.D, as a divine response to a Basilian monk's doubt about Jesus' Real Presence in the Eucharist. Free time for lunch (not included) After lunch continue to Assis, where we will arrive in the afternoon. Check in at the hotel and accommodation. Rest of the day free.

#### Mar 17, Mon: Assisi

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning meet your guide and start your tour of Assis. Explore the hilltop birthplace of St Francis. In the Crypt of St Francis Basilica laid the tomb of one of the most beloved saints of all the time, St Francis of Assisi. During the tour, your group will have the opportunity to view a series of frescoes depicting his life, as well as, view a few of the saint's possessions. next we shall visit the Basilica of saint Clare and the Crucifix from which Jesus spoke to St Francis. Free time for lunch (not included) Afternoon at leisure for prayer or personal activities.

#### Mar 18, Tue: Rome-Split-Medjugorje

Early morning departure from Rome airport for our flights to Split, Medjugorje. Upon arrival we will meet our guide/driver then transfer to the village of Medjugorje for dinner & overnight.

#### Mar 19, Wed & Mar 20, Thu: Medjugorje

The most beautiful features of Medjugorje are its simplicity and peace. Over the next 2 nights/ 3 days in Medjugorje, we may experience our faith grow, and share in the faith journey of pilgrims from all over the world. Attend Daily Mass: Each morning at 10:00 AM, our group will assemble at St. James Church for Mass (English-Speaking). At the end of each Mass, regardless of language, there is a blessing of the religious articles that you have with you.

On Feast Days, and Sundays: English Mass is at 12 PM. Option A: Climb Apparition Hill: This mountainous hill is where the visionaries first encountered Our Lady. At the base of this hill is a Blue Cross, where it is said Our Lady appeared to the children while they hid from the communist police in the early days of the alleged apparitions. While climbing, our group is invited to recite the Rosary, pausing five times for each decade of the Rosary. At the top of the hill, we will witness the exact location of the first alleged apparition of Our Lady to the visionaries, and enjoy private time for prayer.

Option B: Climb Mt. Krizevac (Cross Mountain): In 1933, the villagers built a 30' high cross atop a mountain to commemorate Jesus' passion and death on the cross. Your group will have the opportunity to climb this mountain, and venerate that very cross. While climbing, your group is invited to pray the Stations of the Cross (to meditate on Jesus' suffering Road to Calvary), pausing fifteen times for each Station.

Mar 21, Fri: Return Home from Sarajevo Airport.
