



Day-by-Day Itinerary

Dec 2, Mon: Departure (IAH, TX) KLM 662 at 3:25 pm Dec 3, Tues: Rome-Arrival (FCO, IT) KLM 1603 11:55am

Arrival, assist by a representative to the bus, transfer to the hotel for dinner & overnight.

Dec 4, Wed: Rome-Papal Audience-Catacombs

Following breakfast, we will make our way to St. Peter's Square to attend the Papal Audience, led by His Holiness, Pope Francis. (Papal Audience is scheduled to take place every Wednesday, pending the schedule of Pope Francis.) Free time for lunch (not included). Following the Audience, we will visit the Catacombs, where the early Christians hid themselves to escape persecution. The tour will continue with the visit to St. Paul, outside the Walls. Continue our tour via the Appian Way -- the oldest road from Roman times -- plus the famous Domine Quo Vadis Chapel; see the ancient Baths of Caracalla, Arch of Drusus; Tomb of Caecilia Metella. Dinner & overnight in Rome

Dec 5, Thu: Rome-Vatican-Basilica of St. John the Lateran and St. Mary Major-Holy Steps

Breakfast at the hotel. Today, with your guide, we will visit the Vatican Museums, containing a group of the most impressive edifices with hundreds of galleries filled with art treasures. See awe-inspiring relics and works of art donated throughout centuries as tributes of faith. We'll cover The Tapestry Gallery, The Raphael Rooms, and the most overwhelming Sistine Chapel, Michelangelo's Masterpiece, restored mural of the Last Judgment. Next we make our way back into St. Peter's Basilica. Pope Francis visited the tomb of St. Peter, following his elevation, for a visit of devotion that lasted 45 minutes. He is the first Pontiff to visit the necropolis since extensive archaeological excavations were conducted at the ancient site decades ago. We will also visit the tomb of St. John Paul II located at the Vatican. Free time for lunch (not included). In the afternoon, we will visit the Basilica of St. John the Lateran, the Pope's cathedral church where relics of both Peter and Paul remain under the main altar. It was here that Pope Francis was formally installed as Bishop of Rome. Next we see the Holy Staircase, which is believed to be a staircase from Pilate's palace in Jerusalem and brought to Rome by St. Helen in the 4th Century. Time permitting, we may climb the steps on our knees in memory of Christ's Passion. Continue to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, the most important and the oldest church dedicated to Our Lady. St. Mary Major contains a relic from the Manger of the infant Jesus. At the end of the tour, transfer back to the hotel for dinner & overnight.

Dec 6, Fri: Rome–Monte Cassino–San Giovanni Rotonda Breakfast at the hotel and check out. In the morning departure with our private bus with destination to San Giovanni Rotondo. Before reaching San Giovanni Rotondo, we will stop in Monte Cassino for a visit at the Monastery of the Benedictine Order, founded by

St. Benedict around 530 A.D. Then we shall drive (approximately three hours) toward San Giovanni Rotonda, the hometown of St. Padre Pio. We will stop on the way for lunch (not included). After lunch, once arrived in San Giovanni Rotondo, check in and accommodation at the hotel. Rest of the day free.

Dec 7, Sat: San Giovanni Rotonda-St. Michael's Cave Breakfast at the hotel. We start our day early after breakfast with a visit to the Church of Padre Pio; known as (Pio da Pietrelcina in Italian). He is venerated as a Saint of the Catholic church. He became famous for exhibiting stigmata for most of his life, thereby generating much interest and controversy. He was both beatified (1999) and canonized (2002) by Pope John Paul II. Then we drive to St. Michael's Cave. We visit the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel, a shrine consecrated by St. Michael. At this grotto, St. Michael appeared to a Bishop to assure him that his diocese would not be annihilated as he feared. Free time for lunch (not included). At the end of the visit, return at the hotel in San Giovanni Rotondo and rest of the day at leisure. Dinner (not included). Overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo.

Dec 8, Sun: San Giovanni Rotondo-Lanciano— Assisi Breakfast at the hotel and check out. After breakfast we leave San Giovanni Rotondo and drive to the city of Lanciano to visit the "Sanctuary of Eucharistic Miracle." This wondrous event took place in the 8th Century A.D, as a divine response to a Basilian monk's doubt about Jesus' Real Presence in the Eucharist. Free time for lunch (not included). After lunch, continue to Assisi, where we will arrive in the afternoon. Check in at the hotel and accommodation. Rest of the day free.

Dec 9, Mon: Assisi

Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning meet your guide and start your tour of Assisi. Explore the hilltop birthplace of St. Francis. In the Crypt of St. Francis Basilica laid the tomb of one of the most beloved saints of all time, St. Francis of Assisi. During the tour, your group will have the opportunity to view a series of frescoes depicting his life, as well as view a few of the saint's possessions. Next we shall visit the Basilica of St. Clare and the Crucifix from which Jesus spoke to St. Francis. Free time for lunch (not included). Afternoon at leisure for prayer or personal activities.

Dec 10, Tue: Assisi-Gubbio-La Verna-Assisi

Breakfast at the hotel. This morning we will ride through the beautiful Umbrian mountains to Gubbio. Following Mass, we visit the town of Gubbio, which seems painted onto the hill, a succession of backdrops against which towers and houses stand out, surrounded by walls. Through the power of God, St. Francis freed the town from a terrible and fierce wolf that afflicted it. After lunch, on our own we will continue to La Verna, the place where St. Francis received the stigmata in 1224. At the end of the daily tour, transfer to Rome. Dinner & overnight at the hotel.

Dec 11, Wed: Return Home from Rome.
