## **Oct 11, Sat: Departure**

**Oct 12, Sun: Rome:** Arrival at FCO international airport, Rome, assist by a representative to the bus. Transfer to the hotel for check in, spend the afternoon at leisure then dinner & overnight at the hotel.

**Oct 13, Mon: Rome-St. John Paul II- Catacombs-Colosseum:** After Breakfast at the hotel we visit the tomb of St. John Paul II. Then we begin the short journey down the Appian Way, the earliest road of the Ancient Rome. This road will lead to the Domine Quo Vadis Chapel, the Baths of Caracalla, the Arch of Drusus, the tomb of Cecilia Metella and the Catacombs of St. Callixtus. The day concludes with a visit to the Basilica of St. Paul outside the Walls. Originally founded by Emperor Constantine in the 4th century, this Basilica is the place of Saint Paul the Apostle. Afterwards we visit the Colosseum and head back to the hotel for dinner & overnight.

**Oct 14, Tue: Rome-Vatican Basilicas:** Today we visit St Peter basilica which gathers inside 2000 years of history and famous works of art such as the Pietà by Michelangelo, you will see the most impressive of edifices, galleries, and awe-inspiring relics. Additionally, our group will have the opportunity to visit the Vatican museum to observe the Tapestry Gallery, Raphael Rooms, Sistine Chapel, and Michelangelo's Masterpiece. Continue to other Basilicas of Rome's Mary Major which contain relic from the manger of the Infant Jesus, The papal Arch basilica, St. John in Lateran and the Holy stairs from Pontius Pilate's palace of Jerusalem during the time of Jesus. It is also said that this Staircase was brought to Rome by St. Helen in the 4th century. Back to the hotel for dinner & overnight.

## **Oct 15, Wed: Papal Audience-Orvieto- Florence**

After an early breakfast at the hotel, we attend the Papal Audience in St. Peter's Square! This Audience is celebrated each Wednesday by His Holiness, Pope Francis (subject to the holy father's schedule). Then we travel to Orvieto, the town that sits on a 1,000-foot-high rock formation, poetically crowned by Italy's most renowned Gothic cathedral. Because of its strategic location, Orvieto for centuries served as a refuge for the popes in troubled times. We visit the famous Cathedral housing the corporeal of the Miracle of the Eucharist in Bolsena. Free time for lunch then proceeds to Florence for dinner & overnight.

**Oct 16, Thu: Florence:** Breakfast at the hotel then we meet our guide and visit the art capital of the world and home to superb churches. We soon discover why Florence is the undisputed cradle of the Renaissance era. Here one almost breathes art and culture in its charming medieval streets, in

craftsmen's workshops, Renaissance palaces, and the world-renowned museums, all found within the downtown area of Florence. Visitors can admire the outstanding work of Brunelleschi, the cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore. Right next to it is the Baptistery with "the Gates of Paradise". Another interesting place is the market place by the river Arno and the famous Ponte Vecchio bridge full of goldsmith shops. Cross the river to the top of Michelangelo Square, where there is a wonderful overview of the city. Free time for lunch (not included) In the afternoon free time, then dinner & overnight at the hotel in Florence.

**Oct 17, Fri: Florence-Pisa-Florence:** After breakfast, we drive to Pisa. starting from Keith Haring's graffiti and passing the lovely Lungarno and its medieval neighbourhoods. Continue to Cavalieri Square before finishing at the magnificent Miracle Square, where we visit Pisa Cathedral (Duomo), which is one of the most impressive churches in Tuscany, Italy. A masterpiece of Pisan Romanesque architecture chiefly famous for its bell tower, the Leaning Tower of Pisa. Rest of the day at leisure, dinner & overnight at the hotel.

**Oct 18, Sat: Florence- San Gimignano- Siena:** This morning after breakfast, we transfer to San Gimignano a small walled medieval hill town in the province of Siena, known as the Town of Fine towers. Free time to visit. We then continue to Siena the birthplace of Saints Catherine and Bernardino. Stroll the Piazza Del Campo, and visit the Cathedral and the Basilica of saint Francis, containing the miraculous consecrated host that remained intact since 1730. Dinner & overnight in Siena.

**Oct 19, Sun: Siena-Perugia-Assisi:** After breakfast we visit Perugia where St. Francis was imprisoned during 13th century wars – visit the cathedral with the tombs of two popes and Mary's 'ring'. Free time for lunch then continue to Assisi; Explore the hilltop birthplace of St Francis. In the Crypt of St Francis Basilica laid the tomb of one of the most beloved saints of all the time, St Francis of Assisi. During the tour, our group will have the opportunity to view a series of frescoes depicting his life, as well as, view a few of the saint's possessions. next we will visit the Basilica of saint Clare and the Crucifix from which Jesus spoke to St Francis. Dinner & overnight in Assisi.

**Oct 20, Mon: Assisi- Rome:** After breakfast at the hotel, we will visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli with Porziuncola. Then we proceed to Rome, rest of the day at leisure. Dinner & overnight at our hotel in Rome.

**Oct 21, Tue: Return home from Rome / Meeting Day.**
